Jessamyn Lovell, BFA Rochester Institute of Technology, MFA California College of the Arts is an artist and educator living in Albuquerque, NM. She spent the past eleven years working on Catastrophe, Crisis, and Other Family Traditions, a personal and social documentary photography project about her family in Syracuse, NY where she grew up. Most recently, she has been working on a project about an estranged family member called Untitled Project in which she tries to build a portrait of someone she does not know without them knowing. Her photographs have been exhibited nationally, and she is the recipient of many awards, including the 2007 Aperture Portfolio Prize. Her work has also gained recognition and support from such institutions as the SF MoMA, Magnum Photos, Light Work, Richmond Art Center, and SF Camerawork.
